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2) First Article:

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"Spice Up Your Web Site With Rotating Images"  
  by Herman Drost  
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Normally I don't like moving objects when I arrive at a web site. It distracts visitors from getting to the content. However, many web sites could enhance their visitor's experience by creating rotating images on the home page. Here's a good example:

Let's look at some of the benefits of rotating images:

1. Visitors don't need to drill down to the internal pages of your web site to find your images. All your images can be placed on the home page for easy viewing.
2. "Pictures are worth a thousand words" - If the rotating images are high quality and provide an overview of your best products, they give your visitor a better impression than trying to say it with words.
3. Timing of rotations, can be adjusted - with this script, you can speed up or slow down the viewing sequence of your images.
4. Show many images - you can insert as many images as you need, although I would suggest showing only the best ones, because Internet Users tend to be impatient and won't spend more than a few seconds on your web page.
5. Automatic rotation - when someone visits your site, the images will rotate automatically like a slide show, thus adding to the interactivity of your web site.

How to install the image rotation script

1. Copy the image rotation script from:
<http://simplythebest.net/info/dhtmlscript66.html> and paste it into the head and body tags of your web page.
2. Set up the viewing order of your images and number them accordingly i.e. i.e. 1.gif, 2.gif, 3.gif etc. (Give each

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image a number, not a name like danish.gif... it will only produce errors).

3. Optimize your images - reduce the resolution of each of your images to 72ppi to make them suitable for the web. Large images will slow down the loading of your web page.
4. Change the time interval between rotations - I set mine to 3 seconds instead of the 5 seconds provided by the script. This allows the images to be seen quickly enough to keep your visitor's attention.
5. Insert the first image of your slide show on the page and place a link to the URL of your web page.
6. Save and upload the images and web page to your server (web host).
7. Check your script - view your web page online to confirm that everything is working correctly.

Optimize Your Web Page for the Search Engines.

This script places a lot of javascript code in the header tags of your web page, thus pushing your text further down the page. Search engines tend to first spider the top portion of the code in your web page. Therefore it is imperative to reduce the amount of code on the page, especially in the header tags.

Here is how to do this:

1. Place the javascript code in an external file - copy and paste the code (remove the beginning and end script tags) in a text file, name it something like my.js and save it. This will reduce the code to just one line.
2. Insert the external file between the header tags of your web page i.e.

```
<header>  
<script language="JavaScript" src="home.js"></script>  
</header>
```

3. Upload your my.js file and web page to the server.

That's it!

Web Copy Tip

Search engines will only spider text (not images) near the top of your web page, therefore create an optimized paragraph of text before the rotating images. Place your most highly targeted keywords in this paragraph and also include these keywords in the title and description tags of your meta tags. This will increase your chances of getting good rankings in the main search engines, thus attracting free traffic to your web site.

2Checkout makes especially then sense over your own merchant account, when you are just starting out and don't take in a certain amount to cover monthly fees.

If you on the other hand only need to accept payments from customers in the 38 countries that PayPal accepts, then PayPal is a good choice.

2. How do you separate subscribers into text and HTML and do you need to publish 2 newsletters? Or is software like incredi-mail better.

(Question submitted by: Charles Miesel)

Robert A. Kearse :

"Use an autoresponder that can send BOTH plain text and HTML simultaneously. No need to separate subscribers in the data base."

Donald Younglove :

"Send emails in text with a link to same newsletter in HTML they can click on to get it in other version."

Rev. Dr. John Lock <ifc@churchsociety.net> :

"Most people use HTML/web based emails now so this shouldn't be a problem. One newsletter should suffice."

Gary R Moore <garym@ipa.net> :

"Software is better."

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Mel Waxman <LoseWeightNow@adelphia.net> :

"I have been using IncrediMail for a number of years and love it. It is easy to use and will download email from different servers."

Shirley Grant <webmaster@shirleymoneymachine.com> :

"I use a script called ListMail Pro. The script is installed on your own website and it can tell whether a subscriber is able to receive html. If they are not, it will send a text version of your message."

Steve Yakim <yakim1@comcast.net> :

"I have always published an HTML newsletter, but when I sent a test email to my own email address and my autoresponder said the email was sent without error and I never received it, I discovered my own ISP was filtering my email without my knowledge.

I now send a newsletter in text format and put an HTML version on the Internet. This way my subscribers can read the text version in the email or the HTML version on the Internet.

I use an HTML template of my newsletter and copy paste the text version into the template. This way I only have to make simple changes to the HTML copy before uploading to the Internet.

The HTML newsletter was so much easier for me to format compared to the text emails. I am still learning to get everything right the first time."

"Hello, Charles, the easiest way is to find an autoresponder service that will allow the client to CHOOSE which they prefer. I usually publish two newsletters to accomplish this,
and would love to know if there's an easier way. Of course if the FTC gets their way April 20, none of us except the happy little sp'am'mers will be in business anymore via email anyway... *sigh* Good luck to you."

Saumil Patel <sam_ezines@yahoo.co.in> :

"Most autoresponders have the feature built into them. You have to draft 2 different copies for each of the mails, and the autoresponder will then take care about sending the correct one to the subscribers. (i.e. as per their needs)"

Comments: There are two ways to solve this problem and both have advantages and disadvantages.

1. You could use a software / script like Add2it Mailman Pro or ListMail Pro to send out both message types (plain and HTML) together in one MIME message.

A little note in between... IncrediMail might be an incredible piece of software, but it is not a mailing list management software. It is a product to replace MS Outlook or Outlook Express. Ok, that said, back to the subject...

Then those receivers that have viewing HTML messages disabled would automatically see the plain text version of your message instead.

The advantage of this method would of course be that you don't need to manage two lists.

But there are several disadvantages with this approach...

- a) The email size would be bigger, which in turn takes longer to send out, gives the filters more material to "complain" about and also costs you more due to higher bandwidth usage.
- b) Those people that can't read HTML email due to the use of ancient browser types are also most likely not able to work properly with MIME messages that contain a plain text plus a HTML version of the message.

2. You could setup two lists within Add2it Mailman Free, Standard or Pro and then let subscribers choose between plain text version and HTML version via a dropdown menu or radio buttons.

The advantage with this method would be that...

- a) Your subscribers could choose plain text if they prefer, even if their browser is able to display HTML messages.

b) Also the message size send would be smaller as not all subscribers get everything (less bandwidth usage / cost).

c) Next there is less that can get caught in the filters and those messages can be send faster.

The only disadvantage with this method that I can think of is that you would have to send each message type to each list separately.

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4) Second Article:

"Internet News Services Explode Online"
by Jim Edwards

It seems no matter how much information comes available online, people thirst for more.

To illustrate this point, just take a look at all the online news services sprouting up on the web like garden weeds.

With the click of a mouse you can instantly search thousands of news sources for specific and timely information on virtually any topic you choose.

Heck, if you're a real news "junkie," you can even get up-to-the-minute news emailed straight to your in-box!

Now, I'm the first one to say that nothing beats a good old-fashioned newspaper you hold in your hands.

Few things rate as relaxing as a cup of coffee, a quiet morning, and today's newspaper ready for my inspection. In fact, my day doesn't officially start until I walk to the end of my driveway to retrieve the paper (occasionally from under a bush).

But as much as I love the paper, it rarely contains stories on highly-specialized subjects such as the latest email marketing laws, html parsing, and search engine promotion.

Of course, it doesn't make sense for virtually any local newspaper to carry news about email marketing laws (other than how they affect consumers), because the market demand simply doesn't exist on that level.

However, around the world, thousands of people just like me want to know the instant a news story breaks on the latest "Can Spam" legislation, and that's where online news services come into play.

Log on to <http://news.google.com>, <http://news.yahoo.com> and www.news.com to search thousands of different news sources from around the world.

On these sites you can dig up information on anything from

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current world events and your favorite Spanish soccer team, to cattle tagging regulations in Argentina (no kidding) and the exploding online auction markets in mainland China.

News from around the world on virtually any subject waits literally just a few keystrokes and a mouse-click away.

An incredibly useful feature offered by many of these sites includes email notification based on your keyword search criteria.

So instead of paying a "clipping" service to find articles and send them to you, these websites will do it free.

Now how could you use this type of news notification service?

Well, imagine you own stock in a specific company.

You could subscribe to a number of different news services and have them send you breaking stories about the company, CEO, affiliated companies, and anything else you choose.

All you do is enter in the names, companies and keywords you want them to bird dog, and they'll send you an email every time they find a new story for you.

For example: Let's say you want to know the instant someone publishes a story about "ebay" or "online auctions"... it's as simple as logging on to one of the news services, putting in the keyword phrase, and giving them your email address.

You can even specify to have them send you the updates as they happen or only once a day (probably a good idea for more active topics).

Another example: Let's say you deal in a very specific industry, such as real estate investment publishing.

You could sign up to get notified any time a news story gets published about changing regulations, interest rates, or other factors affecting your business.

All this online news certainly does not rate a substitute for morning coffee, local and national news, and an important ritual to start the day, but it has a place, especially for extremely specialized areas of interest, hobbies, or business news.

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Watch for many new services, software, and opportunities to arise from this growing and dynamic area of online publishing.

1CellNet offers a highly consumable product which is Internet telephony from your cell / mobile phone. The great thing about 1CellNet is that you can generate calls even without an Internet connection. Yes, you can make an Internet phone call from the middle of the road.

I personally started using and testing 1CellNet on the 23rd of January.

Their rates are in many countries around the globe truly lower than normal mobile rates. The calling method is quiet simple as well.

The 1CellNet website itself does a pretty poor job in telling potential customers on how easy it is to make calls. At first I lost interest when I saw it saying that you have to SMS with "C destination number". I couldn't figure out how you can quickly make calls without having to type the actual number in.

Then I was told by a friend who has been a member for a while that once you signed up, you have your own web page and access to a members area in which you can create shortcuts, e.g. I have my brothers's number as ANDI=494342xxxxxx.

Then when you SMS the gateway you just put in the msg part as "C ANDI" and way it goes. What happens next is the gateway will

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call you, once you receive the call you will hear the destination phone ring. It's so simple to use!

It's also not a simple reseller program. Many reseller programs force people to buy cosmetic or health product... These are not our essential daily needs. But the phone calls are made daily by us.

Since I joined, I personally sponsored three affiliates and one customer into 1CellNet, not much as I didn't promote it much.

Still, I have now already a 1CellNet team of 10 consultant's and over 40 affiliate's and a bunch of customers. So, I can say that their system did work very well for me. :)

As you can see, the beauty of the 1CellNet binary compensation plan is that it's highly viral. Once you get the ball rolling things move very fast.

New affiliates get \$130 of phone-to-phone credit plus \$20 of PC-to-phone credit for a one-time payment of \$199. And if that's more than you would want to invest, they offer also to start as an Consultant for a one-time payment of \$99 including \$50 worth of talk time.

So, the opportunity to virtually have your own mobile calls reseller business at practically no cost is pretty awesome.

But even without consider to make money, it can save you money on your bill. The question is why not? If you can make money from it, it is great. If not, you still save on your bill.

And for those that are not interested to earn an income, they offer customer account for a one-time fee of \$70 including \$50 worth of talk time.
